For over fifty years, AHRC New York City has provided essential and high quality services to people with mental retardation and developmental disabilities.

A Community Resource

AHRC's Article 16 Clinic offers a wide range of clinical services at two clinics and various sites in the five boroughs.

Who Can Receive Services

Clinical services at AHRC are offered to individuals with developmental disabilities from age 5 through the senior years. In addition, certain support services can be provided to other family members who do not themselves have a disability.

Payment

Most services provided are covered by Medicaid and/or Medicare. If an individual does not have Medicaid or Medicare, we may be able to help obtain it. If you are a member of an HMO or other managed care plan, you may or may not be eligible to receive certain services. For individuals with no coverage, we offer a sliding scale fee. Please check with us for details.

When and Where Are Services Provided

Services are offered at the AHRC Main Office Monday through Friday, 8 AM - 7 PM and Saturday, 10 AM - 5 PM.
