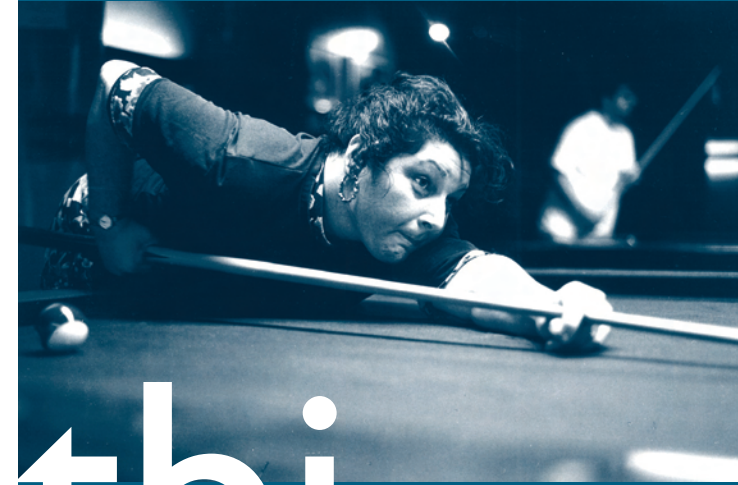

TBI Structured Day Program

The AHRC TBI Structured Day Programs are community-based rehabilitation services designed specifically for individuals with a traumatic or acquired brain injury. The basic goals of the service are to:

- ⌘ Develop and enhance functional independent living skills
- ⌘ Increase socialization opportunities
- ⌘ Promote community inclusion
- ⌘ Develop problem-solving skills
- ⌘ Develop and enhance the use of compensatory strategies

Rehabilitation goals are worked on in supervised community settings, as well as structured groups. Participants are provided with a full day of community-based skill development through a variety of educational, cultural, and volunteer opportunities. Psychological services are available at both sites.

The Structured Day Program sites are completely wheelchair accessible and transportation can be provided to and from the sites to attend the programs from all 5 boroughs in NYC (Queens, Upper Manhattan and Bronx residents are served in the Bronx; residents of all other boroughs are served at the Brooklyn site).

The AHRC Structured Day Program is an approved provider under the OMRDD and DOH Waiver. Third party payment is also accepted.
